## 2023 Camp Homewood Student Code of Conduct

While students are participating in the Camp Homewood Leadership Trip, it is expected that students will represent their families and school in a respectful, considerate and safe manner at all times.

Students have signed the annual "code of conduct" that covers their behavior in school and on all school related field trips, that includes the Camp Homewood Leadership Trip September 18 -22, 2023

In addition, given the unique circumstances of the field trip, students will be required to follow the subsequent guidelines:

- Attendall scheduled meeting and meal times (meals, bus departures, chapel, and curfews)
- Hang out in public/assigned spaces during unstructured time (not in individual rooms)
- Remain in designated areas in camp
- Refrain from going to rooms of opposite genders
- Refrain from alcohol or drug consumption or use of any illegal substances
- Keep rooms tidy (to be checked daily)
- Remain in assigned room after curfew
- Refrain from inappropriate media in rooms
- Refrain from using cell phones for communication or entertainment
- Leave tables in dining room/patio tidy

Date

- Remain in muster teams when noting eneral activity times at camp including airports, bus rides, outdoor activity groups, and whale watching
- Respect and follow guidelines of Camp Homewood staff at all times
- Follow safety procedures for camp and whale watching

If a student does not adhere to these guidelines, students may be required to remain under teacher supervision.

In addition, in extreme infractions - if deemed necessary by administration - parents may be required to come pick up their son/daughter from Comox airport.
