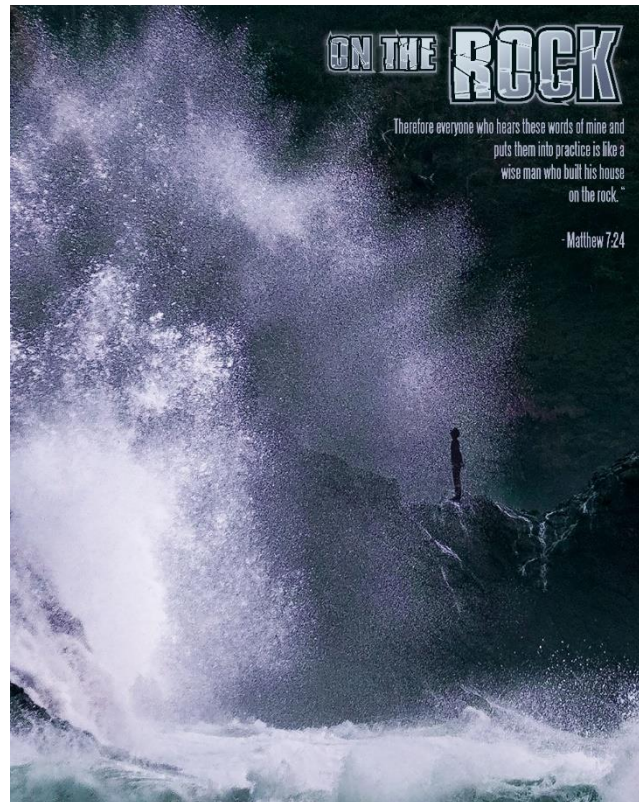

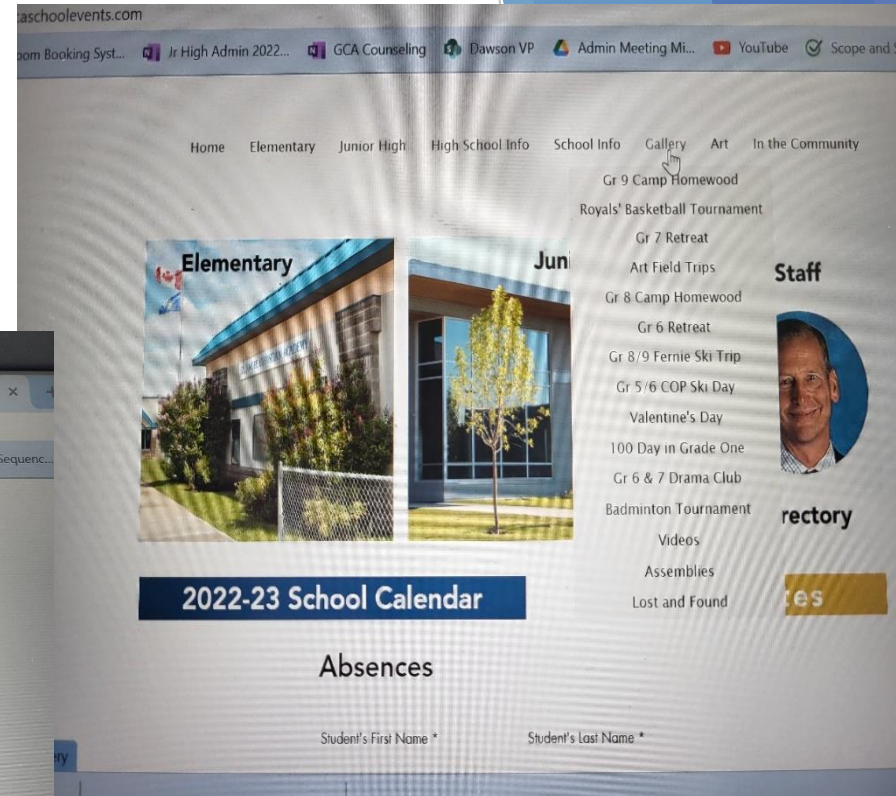
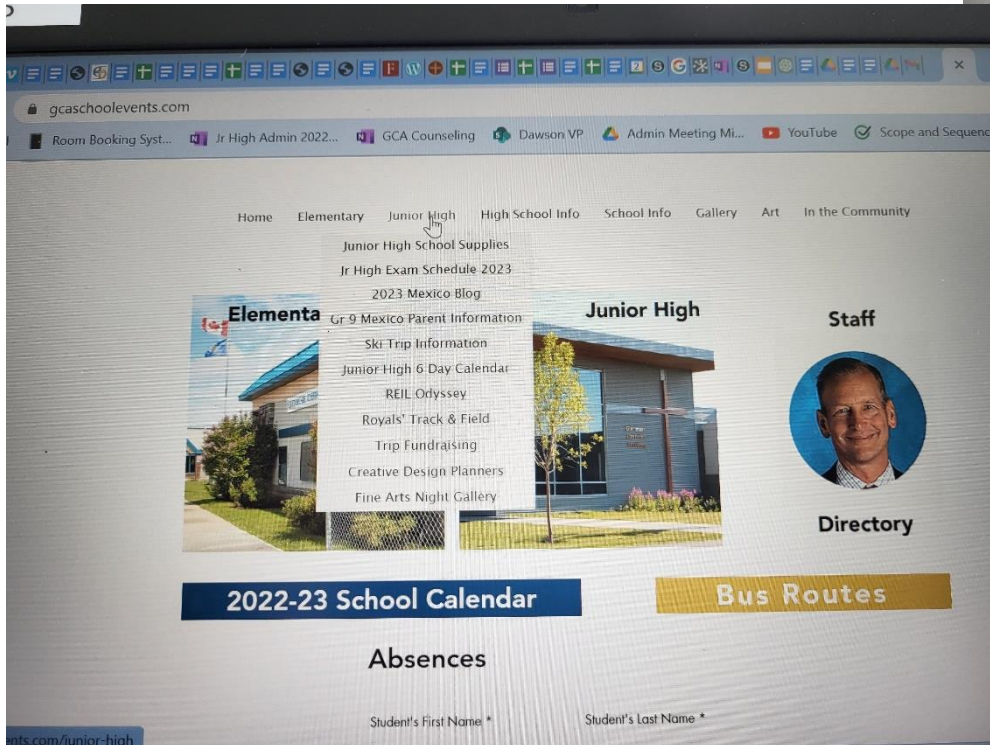
Logic


