

2023 Fernie Ski Trip Student Code of Conduct

While students are participating in the Fernie Ski Trip, it is expected that students will represent their families and school in a respectful, considerate and safe manner at all times. Students have signed the annual 'code of conduct' that covers their behavior in school and on all school related field trips that includes the Fernie ski trip.

In addition, given the unique circumstances of the field trip, students will be required to follow the subsequent guidelines:

- Attend all scheduled meeting and meal times (meals, bus departures, chapel, and curfews)
- Refrain from running in hallways and moving from room to room in mobs
- Refrain from pool use outside of supervised scheduled times
- Refrain from going to the rooms of opposite genders
- Keep rooms tidy (to be checked daily)
- Remain in assigned room after curfew
- Refrain from inappropriate media in rooms
- Refrain using hotel room telephones
- Refrain from going to other floors of hotel
- Turn in cell phones/personal devices to teacher supervisor at bed time
- Leave tables in dining rooms tidy
- Ski, snowboard, and snowshoe at all times in groups of three or more
- Refrain from alcohol or drug consumption, tobacco, vaping, cannabis products or use of any illegal substances
- Refrain from entering the Fernie Rail Park
- Remain in assigned boundaries at all times
- Attend scheduled ski, snowboard or snowshoe lessons

If a student does not adhere to these guidelines, students may be required to remain in the ski lodge under teacher supervision.

In addition, in extreme infractions – if deemed necessary by administration – parents may be required to come pick up their son/daughter from Fernie.
